All prescriptions and billing related to Zepbound® will be managed through GiftHealth, Revive's licensed pharmacy partner. Patients may see the name "GiftHealth"/LillyDirect® referenced during the fulfillment process. Upon electronic transmission of the prescription from the prescribing physician, GiftHealth will notify the patient via text message and/or email. This communication will include confirmation of the order and a secure link for payment processing.

Revive's Weight Health Program adheres to state-specific regulations concerning the prescription and availability of weight health medications. In Louisiana (LA), compounded GLP-1 weight loss medications are not prescribed. In California (CA) and Alabama (AL), oral compounded semaglutide medications are not included as part of the program. In Mississippi (MS), compounded GLP-1 products are similarly excluded. These guidelines are established in accordance with applicable state laws and Revive's program policies, which are subject to change.
